

Scripture Summary








We do have a 'homeless' challenge here in Georgetown. St. Andrew's volunteers have been contributing to the 'Out of the Cold', downtown Georgetown efforts for the last 3 years. We have been providing Wednesday night coverage, every other week during the winter. A 'crew' of three comes to Knox Presbyterian Church at 8 pm to setup for the overnight guests. Lately there have been 6-8 overnight guests. The evening 'crew' offers to feed the guests a simple meal, often from 'leftovers' of the recent community dinner from the previous Tuesday night. At 10:30 pm the evening 'crew' is relieved of their duties by the overnight 'crew'. The overnight 'crew' is relieved at 6:00 am by the morning 'crew', that prepares breakfast, cleans up and has people on their way by 8:00 am. Needed-two volunteers to work with Joanne Wardle for Wednesday evening, January 1, providing a pause for two of our regular volunteers. The Annual Meeting is Sunday, February 9th.




